Guided Walking Tour of Royal Tunbridge Wells A Visit to Finchcocks Musical Museum

Two memorable experiences in Kent in one day

FOR THE DISCOUNTED PRICE OF £10 PER PERSON (minimum group of 20 people), visitors will join a one-hour guided tour of the famous Pantiles and historic heart of Royal Tunbridge Wells, followed by a tour and personal musical recital at nearby Finchcocks, a beautiful Georgian manor house and garden, home to over 100 historic keyboard instruments.

FINCHCOCKS is a fine Georgian manor set in a beautiful garden and surrounded by unspoilt Kent countryside. Visitors, young and not so young, are treated to a unique and highly entertaining personal recital given by owner and concert pianist, Richard Burnett, featuring some of his collection of historic keyboard instruments brought together over the last 40 years. Finchcocks holds a number of special musical events throughout the year including well-established Fairs, a Midsummer Music Series and a September Music Festival.

ROYAL TUNBRIDGE WELLS has been welcoming visitors for over 400 years. A Guided Walking Tour of the Pantiles and old High St is a wonderful way to discover some of the town's colourful history and to hear about the many famous visitors to 'the Wells' – from Queen Anne to Samuel Pepys. Included in the tour is the opportunity to try a glass of the original Chalybeate Spring water. All tours are conducted by Tourist Board accredited Blue Badge Guides and can be offered in French, Dutch and German or tailor made to suit a particular group interest (by prior arrangement).

SUGGESTED ITINERARY

We recommend you start your day in Royal Tunbridge Wells with a Guided Walking Tour. Allow some time for shopping or browsing in the Pantiles or old High Street and then lunch in one of the many cafés or restaurants in the town.

Finchcocks is situated near the village of Goudhurst, just eight miles from Royal Tunbridge Wells, and is best visited in the afternoon. Start your visit by 2pm when owner, Katrina Burnett will give a brief history of this fine Georgian manor house. Allow a good three hours to explore the beautiful gardens and to view the collection of historic keyboard instruments and the 'Pleasure Gardens Exhibition'. Then be treated to a unique and personal recital given by concert pianist, Richard Burnett, featuring some of the musical collection – entertaining and suitable for all ages. Afterwards you can include afternoon tea as part of your itinerary in the Tea Rooms (must be booked separately).

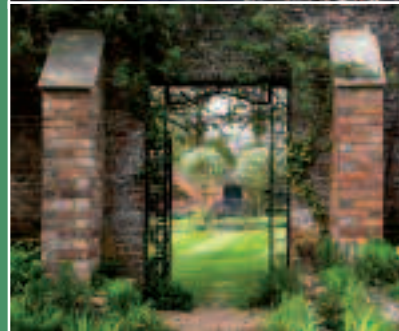
If you prefer to visit Finchcocks in the morning and Royal Tunbridge Wells in the afternoon, this can be easily arranged. Just indicate this when making your booking.
